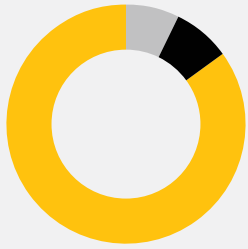

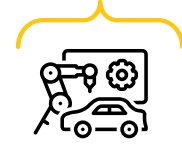
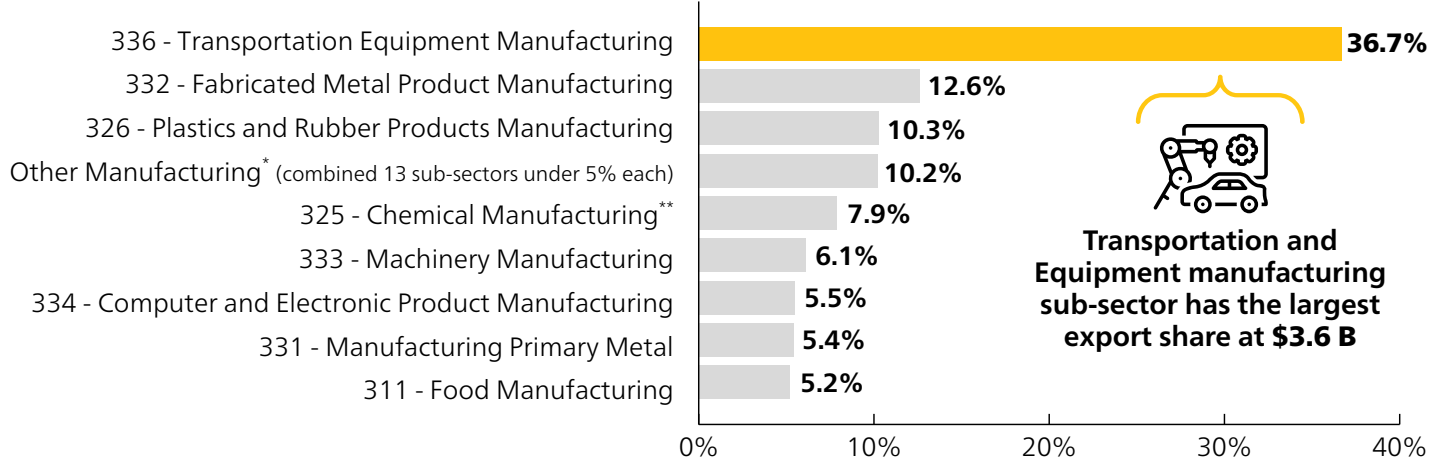

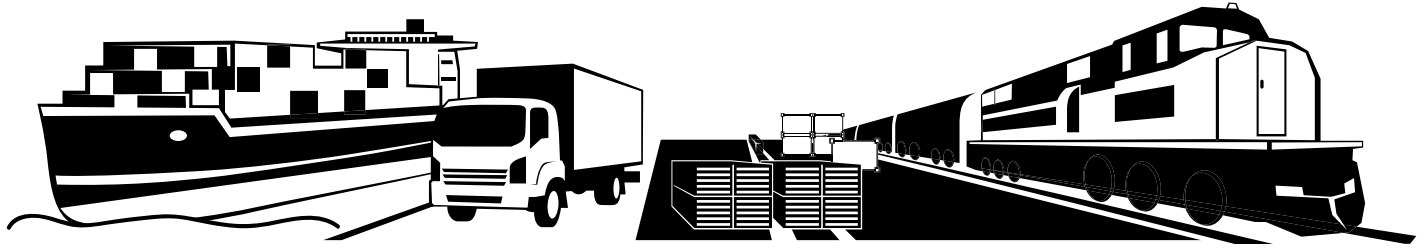

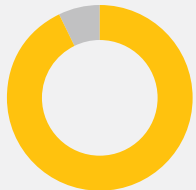

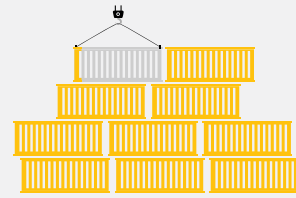


EXPORT DESTINATION
