METHODOLOGY

- All values are in Canadian dollars
- The number of establishments = 0 means the counts were suppressed
- Any blank data points mean no data available
- Industry is determined on the establishment basis
- One establishment can trade with both the United States and non-US. For example, it can export to both the United States and China. Therefore "Total" does not equal "US" + "non-US" for counts, but it does for value. Value may not add to totals due to rounding.



SUMMARY

According to Statistics Canada 2023 data, nearly 2,900 business establishments in York Region export goods and services with an annual total export value of \$14.5 billion. Most exports are to the U.S. with 81% (or \$11.8 billion) of total exports value, remainder of the exports are to non-U.S. countries with 19% (\$2.7 billion).

Manufacturing is by far the largest export sector in York Region with 82% (or \$11.9 billion) of total export value and 87% share of the overall U.S. destination. Wholesale trade is the next largest export at \$1.7 billion (12%) of the total export value.

Transportation equipment manufacturing (including automotive parts) represents the largest share (22%) of the total manufacturing sector export value. Exports of plastics and rubber products and fabricated metal products are also linked to the wider transportation equipment sector, with shares of 10% and 9% of the total export value, respectively.

Employment by exporters is estimated at over 70,000 jobs, representing nearly 12% of jobs in the Region. Over half (53%) of those jobs are with large to very large businesses (greater than 100 employees). Medium businesses (20-99 employees) account for 33% of all jobs and the remaining 14% are with small businesses (less than 20 employees).

In 2023, York Region's total goods imports amounted to \$45.4 billion. Of these, over 62% (\$28.1 billion) originated from non-U.S. countries, while the remaining 38% (\$17.3 billion) came from the U.S. The largest importing sector in the Region was wholesale trade, which accounted for 76% (\$34.3 billion) of the import value. At the enterprise level, over 9,100 establishments in the Region were engaged in import activities.



Share of Export Destination Country



The manufacturing sector has the **largest share of exports in York Region** with \$11.9 billion, followed by wholesale trade at \$1.7 billion (82 % and 12% of total export value, respectively).

The manufacturing sector has the **largest share of total exports of goods and services to the U.S.** at 87 % (\$10.3 billion), including the **largest share of total exports to non-U.S. countries** with 58% (\$1.6 billion).


Transportation equipment manufacturing (including auto parts) represents the largest share (22%) of the **total manufacturing sector export value at \$3.2 billion**. Exports of plastics and rubber products and fabricated metal products are also closely linked to the wider transportation equipment sector (10% and 9%, respectively).


Manufacturing Sub-Sector Exports by Largest Total Value from York Region Companies, 2023

Share of York Region's Manufacturing Sub-Sector Exports by Overall Value, 2023





The **manufacturing sub-sector exports are highly reliant on the U.S. market**, with some having U.S. export value shares exceeding 95 per cent such as food manufacturing and plastic and rubber products.



York Region is home to nearly 2,900 exporters of all sizes. The manufacturing sector represents the largest number of establishments with over 1,000 exporters (35%) of the overall total, followed by the wholesale trade sector with nearly 900 exporters (31%).





80% Nearly 2,400 (over 80%) of the 2,900 establishments in York Region export goods and services predominantly to the U.S.

Manufacturing exporters in York Region has the **largest share of export goods and services to the U.S.** with nearly 40%, followed by wholesale trade at nearly 28%. Wholesale trade exporters have the **largest share of the total exports to non-U.S. countries** with 36%, followed by manufacturing exporters with 35%.



Exporters in York Region represent roughly 12% share of total employment in York Region









Of the 9,100 total importer establishments in York Region, wholesale trade has the largest share with nearly 27% or 2,500 importer establishments, followed by retail trade with 18% or nearly 1,700 establishments.
